Dr. Colin B. Johnson is a dynamic educator, performer, and researcher. As a performer, Dr. Johnson has been heard in many opera houses and theatres across the country as well as in Germany and Italy. His voice has been described as "ebullient" in roles such as Figaro in *Le Nozze di Figaro*, Leporello in *Don Giovanni*, Dr. Dulcamara in *L'elisir d'amore*, Méphistophélès in *Faust*, Caspar in *Der Freischütz*, and Sam in *Trouble in Tahiti*. He has performed with Opera Colorado, Des Moines Metro Opera, Connecticut Opera, Sarasota Opera, Opera Lancaster, and Opera Naples. His other concert works include Baritone Soloist in Vaughan Williams' *Five Mystical Songs*, Brahms' *Requiem*, Elijah in Mendelssohn's *Elijah*, Bass Soloist in Bach's *Christmas Oratorio*, and Handel's *Messiah*.
